General Information

Saint Gregory’s Summer Camp provides an extraordinary summer experience for boys and girls. Each week is packed with challenging group games, enrichment workshops, creative crafts, hilarious skits and songs, and TONS of fun! Weekly themes and workshops change to keep children interested all summer long. We hope that each child leaves with new friends, new skills, feelings of success, and many wonderful camp memories!

Swimming

Every child will participate in a structured skills class each day. All full-day students will have a free swim each day weather permitting.

Rainy Day Activities

Indoor activities proceed as scheduled no matter the weather. When rain curtails outdoor activities, we will offer an entertaining alternative such as an extra sports class in the gym or classroom games.

Lunch and Snack

Juice and snack are provided each day and are covered by tuition. At an added cost, lunches will be available Monday through Friday (Monday –Thursday - Subway subs; Friday - pizza and ice cream). Our ample refrigerator space is used to store lunches brought from home.

Policy

The Saint Gregory’s Summer Camp does not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, creed, or disability in the administration of its admission, education and athletic policies. All children are admitted equally to all opportunities generally available to students at the school. Limited financial aid is available.

Dates/Hours of Operation

We offer six one week sessions, beginning June 28th and ending August 6th. The camp day begins at **9:00am** and ends at **3:30pm** Before and after camp care are also available. Before care is from 8:00am – 9:00am for an added fee of \$25 week. After care is from 3:30pm to 6:00pm for an added fee of \$60 a week. (No per diem rates are available)

Age Limits

All children, age 3 – 12, are accepted on the basis of their age as of July 1. Three year olds may only attend ½ day (9:00am – 12:00pm).

Fees/Refunds

Fee information can be found on the registration form. *Please note that tuition refunds will be granted only up until June 1st.* Parents are responsible for tuition for any withdrawal after June 1st. Please note that if your child is not registered for an entire session, the weekly rates are still applicable.

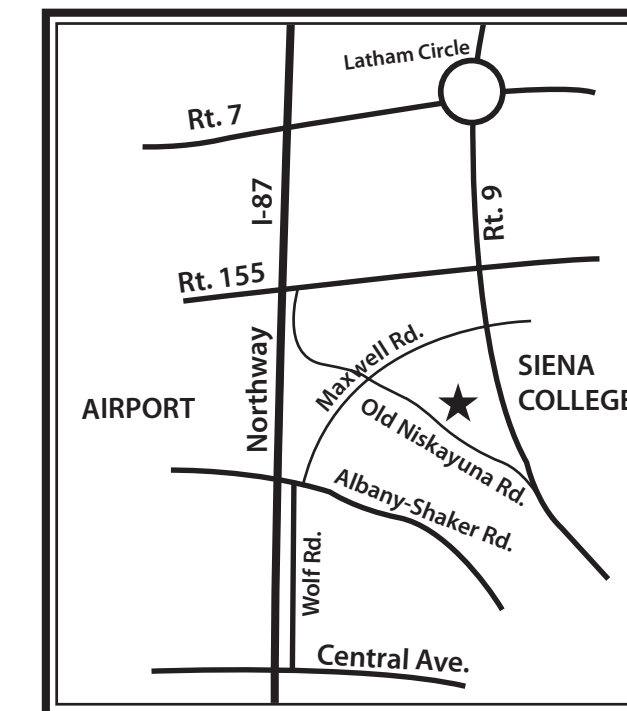

Three years old through First Grade

Saint Gregory's Summer Camp: Foxes and Eagles

Second through Sixth Grade

The Fox (entering second and third grade) and Eagle (enter fourth through sixth grade) programs combine enrichment workshops with all of our traditional camp activities such as swimming, sports, games, arts and crafts! Children travel through their morning activities with their group and learn to work, socialize and have fun together. In the afternoon, campers choose from a wide variety of one hour enrichment workshops and work closely with a teacher on skills they would like to develop more fully. All campers participate in a structured morning swim program and a free swim in the afternoon.

Enrichment Workshops:

Kaleidosports (Offered all 6 weeks)

Campers will participate in a different sporting event each day! They will be involved in basketball, kickball, pickle ball, capture the flag and many more!

Cooking (Offered all 6 weeks)

Look out Rachel Ray! The summer kitchen bubbles with excitement again this year as campers learn to prepare delicious dinners and scrumptious desserts!

Arts and Crafts (Offered weeks 2, 4, and 6)

Paint, string, glue, colored paper, clay and much more will be used to create personalized projects during this workshop. Every day campers will have the opportunity to use their imaginations and creativity!

Mindstorm (Offered weeks 1, 3, and 5)

Using Lego Mindstorm, campers will build and program a robot. Future engineers – come try out this extraordinary workshop!

Golf (Offered week 1)

Learn to chip and putt like Tiger Woods. Join us on our mini-links as we play in the summer sun!

Make your own Comic Book (Offered week 2)

Start with a superhero that you create and then dream of the adventure your hero will have – by the end of the week you will produce your own comic book featuring your hero in that special adventure.

Summer News (Offered week 3)

Extra! Extra! Read all about it! Camp reporters will design their own newsletter that will be sent home to every camper on Friday.

Computer (Offered week 4)

Have you ever tried "Power Point?" "Paint?" Would you like to develop your skills on the computer? Come and explore these and other programs in this workshop.

Murder Mystery (Offered week 5)

Who? What? Where? In this workshop "Clue" comes to life as students use their detective skills to solve a mystery.

Be a Summer Star! (Offered week 6)

Drama taken to a new level – This workshop is for budding actors and actresses. Campers will collaborate in small groups to act out a skit or short play for the entire camp. They will have tons of fun while learning teamwork and theater skills.
